This is an intuitive tabletbased ECG system, with automatic cloud-upload (subject to Wifi) and immediate online ECG review from any PC or Mac. You can also download and store digital reports or share with the HeartVets cardiologists for an expert interpretation.

The tablet comes with pre-loaded software, ECG device and accessories, and a quick-start guide. Technical support is included with repair or replacement as needed, as well as a cloud account for the whole practice.



Subscribers to our ECG interpretation service receive the ECG kit for free<sup>\*</sup>. Expert help can be requested via the tablet at the time of recording, or through our website: heartvets.co.uk

The ECG interpretation fee of £45 + VAT can be incorporated in your compound ECG fee in the same way blood tests are charged. ## When should I record an ECG?

- Any patient with an arrhythmia auscultated during a consultation, pre-anaesthetic check or during sedation/ general anaesthesia. Making a rhythm diagnosis is key to case management.
- Any animal with a history of weakness or collapse/syncope.
- Dogs with a breed predisposition to dilated cardiomyopathy (DCM) or arrhythmogenic right ventricular cardiomyopathy (ARVC). ECGs are one of the first steps in a regular screening process, before echocardiography or Holter monitoring.
- Pre-anaesthetic checks in cats cardiomyopathy is common • in cats and ECGs can help identify significant disease before it's too late.
